

Once you login to the eBook site using your account you will notice a button “**Download iPublishCentral Reader**”



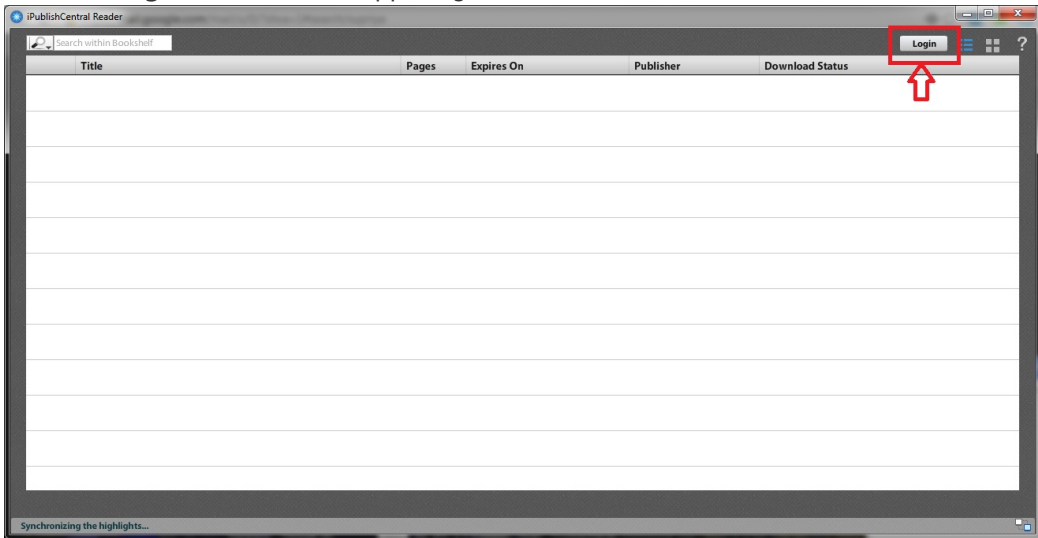

- Click the **Login** button on the upper right corner of the screen.



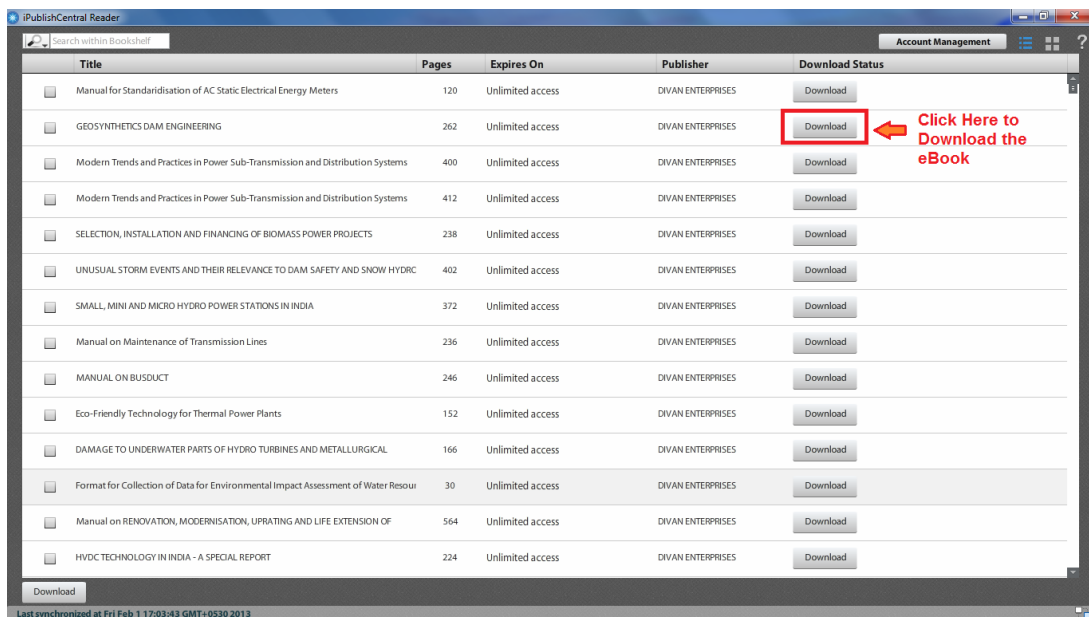
Log in as Institutional User

1. Select **Institutional User**.
2. Enter **www.debooks.in** in the **Site URL** field.

3. Click the **Sign In** button.
4. If the login credentials are incorrect, then an error message will be displayed "**Failed to Authenticate. Invalid Site Information**".
5. Bookshelf displays the subscribed eBooks with a **Download** Button.
6. You need to allow the iPublishCentral Reader to synchronize, this might take a while based on the internet connectivity as the number of titles subscribed to the account is really high.
7. Once synchronized the bookshelf will display the titles with an option to download.
